SENATE BILL DESCRIPTIONS 2026

1. SF0001S20001. Budget Amendment Restoring Governor Gordon’s Entire Budget Recommendation

This amendment sought to fully restore Governor Gordon’s \$11.1 billion budget. Instead of utilizing the power of the purse reserved for the Wyoming Legislature to craft the state’s budget, this amendment would have handed all budgeting power to the Chief Executive.

By abdicating legislative spending authority, this amendment violates WRP Platform Planks #14 and #17, which highlight the importance of checks and balances, the separation of powers, and the fact that taxes must only be used for the constitutional purposes of government. **We have assigned a plus to the NAY votes.** <https://wyoleg.gov/2026/Amends/SF0001S2001.pdf>

This amendment was adopted by the Senate.

2. SF0001S3015. Budget Amendment to Document Petroglyphs

This amendment added nearly half a million dollars over and above the Department of State Parks & Cultural Resource’s budget request to protect petroglyphs on certain state lands and came after the Senate adopted the Governor’s budget in the form of one marathon amendment.

Because historic preservation is not the role of government and because this budget amendment violates WRP Platform Planks #11 and #17, which celebrate the importance of fiscal responsibility, **we have assigned a plus to the NAY votes.** <https://wyoleg.gov/2026/Amends/SF0001S3008.pdf>

This amendment was adopted by the Senate.

3. SF0001S3049. Budget Amendment to Create Local Government Digital Permitting System

This amendment added \$1.5 million to the budget over and above the Governor’s requested budget to help local governments set up digital permit systems, which local governments are already equipped to do on their own.

This unnecessary amendment violates WRP Platform Planks #11 and #17. **We have assigned a plus to the NAY votes.** <https://wyoleg.gov/2026/Amends/SF0001S3049.pdf>

This amendment was adopted by the Senate.



4. SF0065. Wyoming Business Council Repeal.

This bill would have repealed the crony capitalist Wyoming Business Council, a longtime priority of the WRP.

Because this bill supports WRP Platform Plank #11, which stands in defense of the free-market economy and WRP Resolution passed at the May 2022 WRP State Convention in opposition to the Wyoming Business Council, **we have assigned a plus to the AYE votes.** <https://www.wyoleg.gov/Legislation/2026/SF0065>

This bill was killed in the Senate upon introduction.

5. SF0108. Election purity and hand count-2.

This bill would have established hand counting as the standard for all Wyoming elections, removing electronic tabulation systems and enhancing election transparency.

Because this bill supports WRP Platform Plank #23 in defense of election integrity and the November 2025 WRP State Central Committee Resolution demanding hand counts in Wyoming elections, **we have assigned a plus to the AYE votes.** <https://www.wyoleg.gov/Legislation/2026/SF0108>

This bill was killed in the Senate upon introduction.

6. SF0078. Residential real property- taxable value.

This bill would have provided property tax relief by lowering the tax rate for residential properties from 9.5% to 8.3%

Because this bill supports WRP Platform Plank #17 against excessive taxation and multiple WRP resolutions in support of property tax relief, **we have assigned a plus to the AYE votes.** <https://www.wyoleg.gov/Legislation/2026/SF0078>

This bill was killed in the Senate upon introduction.

7. SF0126. Wyoming-Ireland Trade Commission.

This bill would have created a new crony capitalism trade commission to pick winners and losers in the promotion of Wyoming businesses in Ireland.

Because this bill violates WRP Platform Plank #11, which celebrates the free-market economy and decries government undue interference in it, **we have assigned a plus to the NAY votes.** <https://www.wyoleg.gov/Legislation/2026/SF0126>

This bill was killed by the House in Committee of the Whole.



8. SJ0005. Convention of States.

This resolution would have requested Congress to call a constitutional convention pursuant to Article V of the U.S. Constitution.

This resolution violates two WRP Resolutions in opposition to an Article V Convention adopted in 2022 and 2024. **We have assigned a plus to the NAY votes.** <https://www.wyoleg.gov/Legislation/2026/SJ0005>

This bill was killed by the House in Committee of the Whole.

9. HB0010. Sexually explicit materials in libraries- requirements.

This bill would have required all publicly funded libraries to remove obscene, sexually explicit materials from sections of the libraries intended for children, and instead place them in the appropriate section of the library.

This bill supports WRP Resolution against obscene materials in public libraries adopted at the May 2022 WRP State Convention. **We have assigned a plus to the AYE votes.** <https://www.wyoleg.gov/Legislation/2026/HB0010>

This bill was killed in the Senate after Majority Floor Leader Nethercott did not bring it forward for a vote. The vote recorded here refers to an attempt to suspend the rules to bring HB0010 to a vote. This attempt failed.

10. HB0085. Post-election audit procedures.

This bill would have shored up post-election audit procedures, including requiring clerks to keep clean records of such audits and was drafted in response to the failed post-election audit conducted by Weston County Clerk Hadlock during the 2024 general election.

This bill supports WRP Platform Plank #23 in defense of election integrity and the WRP Resolution in support of hand audits adopted at the May 2021 WRP State Central Committee Meeting. **We have assigned a plus to the AYE votes.** <https://www.wyoleg.gov/Legislation/2026/HB0085>

This bill was killed in the Senate on third reading.

1. HB0001 H2001. Budget Amendment Restoring Governor Gordon’s Entire Budget Recommendation

This amendment sought to fully restore Governor Gordon’s \$11.1 billion budget. Instead of utilizing the power of the purse reserved for the Wyoming Legislature to craft the state’s budget, this amendment would have handed all budgeting power to the Chief Executive.

By abdicating legislative spending authority, this amendment violates WRP Platform Planks #14 and #17, which highlight the importance of checks and balances, the separation of powers, and the fact that taxes must only be used for the constitutional purposes of government. **We have assigned a plus to the NAY votes.** <https://wyoleg.gov/2026/Amends/HB0001H2001.pdf>

This amendment was defeated in the House.

2. HB0001 H2045. Budget Amendment For Government Funded Healthcare

This amendment would have added over \$5 million to the budget in order to fund a government-run maternity care system.

Spending more tax dollars on medical care violates multiple WRP resolutions against Medicaid expansion and WRP Platform Plank #17, which states that taxes must only be used for the constitutional purposes of government. **We have assigned a plus to the NAY votes.** <https://wyoleg.gov/2026/Amends/HB0001H2045.pdf>

This amendment was defeated in the House.

3. HB0001 H2079. Budget Amendment to Restore Wyoming Business Council Funding

This amendment would have restored nearly \$50 million to the Wyoming Business Council, a quasi-government agency that funnels tax dollars to private businesses in the name of economic development.

Because this amendment violates WRP Platform Plank #11, which stands in defense of the free-market economy and WRP Resolution passed at the May 2022 WRP State Convention in opposition to the Wyoming Business Council, **we have assigned a plus to the NAY votes.** <https://wyoleg.gov/2026/Amends/HB0001H2079.pdf>

This amendment was defeated in the House, but Governor Gordon used line item veto power to restore all funding to the Wyoming Business Council.



4. HB0001 H3099. Budget Amendment to Provide \$11 Million in State Employee Pay Raises.

This amendment provided for additional state employee pay raises despite state workers receiving roughly 20% in salary increases over the last five years.

Because this amendment violates WRP Platform Plank #17, which states that taxes must only be used for the constitutional purposes of government, **we have assigned a plus to the NAY votes.** <https://wyoleg.gov/2026/Amends/HB0001H3099.pdf>

This amendment was adopted by the House.

5. HB0010. Sexually explicit materials in libraries- requirements.

This bill would have required all publicly funded libraries to remove obscene, sexually explicit materials from sections of the libraries intended for children, and instead place them in the appropriate section of the library.

This bill supports WRP Resolution against obscene materials in public libraries adopted at the May 2022 WRP State Convention. **We have assigned a plus to the AYE votes.** <https://www.wyoleg.gov/Legislation/2026/HB0010>

This bill was killed in the Senate.

6. HB0073. Residential real property- fair market value on transfer.

This bill would have achieved long overdue property tax reform in Wyoming by stopping assessors from taxing unrealized gains on the value of Wyoming homes.

Because this bill supports WRP Platform Plank #17 against excessive taxation and multiple WRP resolutions in support of property tax reform, **we have assigned a plus to the AYE votes.** <https://www.wyoleg.gov/Legislation/2026/HB0073>

This bill was killed in the House upon introduction.

7. HB0094. Election purity and hand count act.

This bill would have established hand counting as the standard for all Wyoming elections, removing electronic tabulation systems and enhancing election transparency.

Because this bill supports WRP Platform Plank #23 in defense of election integrity and the November 2025 WRP State Central Committee Resolution demanding hand counts in Wyoming elections, **we have assigned a plus to the AYE votes.** <https://www.wyoleg.gov/Legislation/2026/HB0094>

This bill was killed in the House upon introduction.



8. HB0186. Baby Olivia Act- requiring human development education.

This bill would have required all public schools to include a video in all human development instruction demonstrating fertilization and the stages of human development from conception until birth, humanizing unborn babies.

Because this bill supports WRP Platform Plank #1, which states that all individuals are endowed by their Creator from the moment of conception, **we have assigned a plus to the AYE votes.** <https://www.wyoleg.gov/Legislation/2026/HB0186>

This bill was killed in the House upon introduction.

9. SF0126. Wyoming-Ireland Trade Commission.

This bill would have created a new crony capitalism trade commission to pick winners and losers in the promotion of Wyoming businesses in Ireland.

Because this bill violates WRP Platform Plank #11, which celebrates the free-market economy and decries government undue interference in it, **we have assigned a plus to the NAY votes.** <https://www.wyoleg.gov/Legislation/2026/SF0126>

This bill was killed by the House in Committee of the Whole.

10. SJ0005. Convention of States.

This resolution would have requested Congress to call a constitutional convention pursuant to Article V of the U.S. Constitution.
